Information from Mrs Chris Gee, Acting Principal, about the return to school for BRIDGEWATER HIGH SCHOOL students

Issued on Tuesday 30 October 2007

Classes will resume on THURSDAY this week

(NOT Wednesday as originally planned)

The Minister for Education, David Bartlett, has announced that:

- classes will resume on THURSDAY this week, 1 November
- students will be taken by bus from Bridgewater High to Geilston Bay High and Claremont College
- our school's **whole building will be demolished**, including the parts that were not burned (structural damage from heat and smoke damage was considerable)

Here is what else we are planning, but bear in mind there could still be changes to the following information so listen to the news each day and check our website (www.bhs.tased.edu.au).

- On <u>Thursday morning</u> this week, we will all meet <u>AT THE PCYC in GREENPOINT ROAD</u>. Arrive at the usual time, 8.30am. Those who come by bus should catch their bus as usual.
- We will have a <u>WHOLE SCHOOL ASSEMBLY</u> for students and staff in the <u>PCYC gym</u> for about 30-45 minutes. As this will be a very special time for us we will <u>restrict admission to</u> <u>our school community only</u>.
- The junior grades grades 7 and 8 will be taken by special buses to GEILSTON BAY HIGH SCHOOL following the assembly.
- The senior grades grades 9 and 10 will be taken by special buses to CLAREMONT
 <u>COLLEGE</u> for their classes following the assembly.
- Your teachers will go to those schools to teach you.
- On Thursday, though, don't go directly to those places: come to the meeting of the whole school at the PCYC.
- <u>Bus arrangements BEYOND Thursday morning</u>: Buses will be available but details of times and pick-up locations are still being worked out (because there are so many existing routes and different contractors to work with). This work is being given top priority.
- On FRIDAY, parents taking grade 7 and 8 students to Geilston Bay High <u>BY CAR</u> are asked to drop them off there at approximately 8.30am, but not before 8.15am
- On MONDAY, TUESDAY and WEDNESDAY this week, 29, 30 and 31 October, your teachers are making preparations for teaching you at the new schools. Therefore, <u>STUDENTS are to STAY HOME on MONDAY</u>, <u>TUESDAY and WEDNESDAY this week</u>. (Originally, the plan was for students to stay home only on Monday and Tuesday but it turns out that we cannot use both schools on Wednesday.)
- When you return on Thursday, be sure to wear your Bridgewater High School UNIFORM.
- On FRIDAY, the grade 9 and 10 students will not be taken to Claremont College (because of another event there) but will have other activities including a BBQ lunch at a park. The activities have not been decided yet but they MIGHT include the Aquatic Centre.

LOCKERS - The grade 9 and 10 lockers were destroyed by the fire. The grade 7 and 8 lockers appear undamaged and will be taken to Geilston Bay High where they will be assessed properly and cleaned. It is expected that grade 7 and 8 students will have access to their lockers on Thursday when they go to Geilston Bay High. Students who have lost items as a result of the fire or have had items damaged by the fire can write out a list of these items with their details, and forward their claim through the school.

REMEMBER - listen to the news and check the school website for more information.

^{*}Students who are scheduled to have **Work Experience** this week should go to their work experience locations as planned.

^{*}Youthbuild will go ahead as usual on Thursday. Students will take part in the assembly at the PCYC first. A bus will then take them to Youthbuild at the Showgrounds.

^{*}Part-time students should come full-time on Thursday and Friday. Their programs will be reviewed.

^{*}The Wilderness Camp that was to have been held this week has now been CANCELLED.

^{*}Students with **library books** and **musical instruments** to return, and **completed assignments** to hand in, should keep these at home until after Friday.
